

Who Needs to See Our Speech-Language Pathologists?

- Children and adults with hearing loss (e.g., hearing aid users, cochlear implant recipients or those who are interested to be implanted).
- Children with learning difficulties, mental disability, developmental delay.
- Children and adults with disfluency or stuttering.
- Children and adults with cleft lip and/or palate.
- Children and adults with voice problems (e.g., poor quality, inappropriate pitch, loss of voice).
- Children and adults with cancer of the mouth, tongue, head and neck.
- Children with autistic spectrum disorders.
- Children and adults with head and neck injury, surgery or stroke.
- Children and adults with any degree of feeding or swallowing difficulty.
- Adults with laryngectomy (removal of larynx/'voice box').

Who Needs to See Our Audiologists?

- At risk babies with conditions such as prematurity, low birth weight, neonatal jaundice (leading to blood transfusion), syndromes, etc.
- Children with speech-language delay and disorders.
- Children who have had diseases known to be associated with hearing loss such as mumps, meningitis.
- Parental suspicion of hearing loss.
- Individuals with balance disorders.
- Individuals with tinnitus.
- Individuals with ear, nose and/or throat (ENT) problems.
- Individuals with a family history of hearing loss.
- Individuals who have hearing difficulties.
- Individuals exposed to noise.
- Patients taking medication which are potentially toxic to the hearing system.
