Billed as Malaysia's most visited tourist attraction, Sunway Lagoon boasts the world's largest Surf Pool, the world's largest man-made beach, and the world's longest suspension bridge at 428 metres long. The theme park also has a man-made volcano, a one of its kind in Malaysia, which erupts with smoke and fire. Visitors can also take a scenic ride on board the Suntrek 2000 monorail, which links to the surrounding Sunway Pyramid Shopping Centre and the Sunway Lagoon Resort Hotel. Sunway Lagoon Resort was also awarded the 'Outstanding Contribution To Tourism' in the private sector for the Malaysia Tourism Awards 2000.

Sunway Lagoon is open from 11.00 am to 6.00 pm daily except Tuesdays, and 10.00 am to 6.00 pm every weekend, public holidays and school holidays.
