Sunway Resort Hotel & Spa had effectively promoted and instilled a safer, healthier and productive work culture and had a total implementation of occupational safety and health management system (OSH-MS) that positioned itself towards self-regulatory compliance.

All winners had undergone an extremely stringent 3 to 4 phases of selection criteria; all of whom have also scored above 85% excellence level. The physical audit exercise was the ultimate deciding factor. When benchmarked against other finalists (Mandarin Oriental and Regent) in the Hotel & Restaurant category, Sunway Resort Hotel & Spa came up tops with an audit scoring points of 92.3% excellence level.
